### Signs of CWD in Deer

- \*Loss of body condition or emaciation (thin or weak)
  - \*Change in behavior such as loss of fear of humans.
  - \*Loss of bodily control or movements.
    - \*excessive drooling & salivating.
- Note-a deer may have CWD but not show symptoms until after 2 yrs of age..
- What to do if you see a sick Deer
- \*Accurately document the location of the animal.
  - \*Call the Report all Poaching Hotline at 1-800-292-7800 or your local DNR Wildlife Office.

\*Hunters that removed a CWD –Positive animal may have their license replaced by the DNR.

### **IMPACTS OF CWD**

\*To date, there have been no reported cases of CWD infection in humans. As a precaution, the U.S. Centers for disease control and prevention recommend that CWD-positive animals not be consumed as food by either humans or domestic animals.

\*CWD is a fatal disease in cervids with no known treatment or recovery.

\*CWD has reduced the deer population locally in other states over the years and has depressed the age structure of deer.  
\*Management efforts are designed to keep the number of infected deer limited.

\*The CWD problem is not just in Michigan. As of August 2018, twenty four other states have CWD in their captive or free-ranging deer populations.

\*A healthy deer herd is important for hunting traditions.

\*Michigan has about 600,000 deer hunters who harvest about 375,000 deer annually.

\*Hunting generates more than \$2.3 billion annually to Michigan's economy.

A 5-County Core CWD area had been created, which includes Ionia, Kent, Mecosta, Montcalm and Newaygo Counties.

A 16-County CWD Management Zone has been created, which includes: Calhoun, Clinton, Easton, Gratiot, Hillsdale, Ingham, Ionia, Isabella, Jackson, Kent, Mecosta, Montcalm, Muskegon, Newaygo, Ottawa & Shiawassee Counties.

## **By-Laws Change**

**186.**

### **Proposed By-Laws Change**

#### Section 1

Any person 18 or older, of good moral character, who is in sympathy with the objects of this club shall be eligible for social membership herein. An application endorsed by three full members must be presented to the club officers and voted on at that meeting.

Three negative votes shall deny membership. New social members will be on a probationary status for a period of one year. During this year, any full member (Senior, Life, etc.) can submit charges against such member and those charges voted on at the next meeting. Three negative votes will terminate this membership.

### **Current By-Laws**

#### Section 1

All persons desiring to join the club must do so as a Social Member. Applications shall be presented to a Club Officer. The prospective members must attend two Business Meetings and/or alternative attendance requirements as specified under Associate member requirements and then be voted on at the third Business Meeting by secret vote. The prospective member must meet these three attendance requirements within a six-month period. Prospective Social Members must be present at the meeting when they are voted on for Social Membership. Membership privileges are the same as for Associate Members, except that they are not eligible for Full Membership
