CWD IN MICHIGAN

WHAT IS CWD?

\*Chronic wasting disease (CWD) is a fatal central nervous system disease found in cervids, such as deer, moose, elk.

\*CWD is caused by a normal protein, called a prion, that misfolds and can infect other deer. These misfolded prions may remain infectious in the environment for years.

\*It affects the central nervous system of infected animals, resulting in brain lesions and neurologic signs.

\*It is transmitted through direct animal to animal contact or by contact with saliva, urine, feces, blood, carcass parts of an infected animal, or infected soil. Prions are extremely resistant in the environment and can stay infectious for years.

\*CWD is a fatal disease; once an animal is infected, there is no recovery or cure for CWD.
